- NON HOMOGENOUS COMMUNITY
- MISSED OPPORTUNITIES FOR SPECIAL GROUPS
- COMPROMISE ON UNIVERSAL ACCESS
- REVERSAL OF ACHIEVED GAINS
- NON VIOLATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS
- ADVOCACY FOR THE VOICELESS
- ADVOCACY TO CHANGE MINDSETS
- ZERO NEW INFECTIONS
- SUSTAINABILITY OF THE RESPONSE
- HEALTHY AND AIDS FREE GENERATION

Gaps – Development Partners

- Some donors still operating outside of national systems;
- Donor systems still onerous and complicated;
- Funding is project based and short term;
- Capacity building programmes not being evaluated;
- Funding mainly for activities

GOVERNMENTS - Gaps

Less money (in absolute terms) being committed to HIV and AIDS; ☐ Some NACs not exerting their authority; ☐Some still dealing with multiple reporting, processes and systems; ☐ Monitoring and evaluation still weak: □CSOs - not true partners ☐ Few with fully costed AIDS plans Policy framework for relationship between gov'ts and CSOs

CONDITIONS OF ENGAGEMENT

Not yet a true partnership; Extractive, Manipulative Combative, Happening only because donors require it!

- TRADITIONALLY RELIANT ON DONORS
- MORE ON GOVERNMENT DONOR FLIGHT
- INCREASING OPPORTUNITY COSTS
- DWINDLING RESOURCES GOV'T, DONORS
- COST SHARING GOV'T DONORS
- PRIVATE SECTOR

Recommendations

Donors

- Review funding instruments to ensure indigenous CSOs benefit;
- Re-think & overhaul capacity interventions.

Governments

- Assert stronger authority in coordination;
- Re-examine division of roles between CSOs and public institutions
- Develop partnerships along mutually agreed principles

CSOs

- Strengthen coordination
- Accept to deal with own accountability
- Strengthen advocacy skills
