Conference Purpose

The 4th Pre-ICASA Conference will draw together the Christian community responding to HIV and AIDS in Africa, to explore and debate, from a Christian perspective, the issues of ownership, scaling-up and sustainability that will be discussed during the main ICASA. During the conference participants will *review* progress of the Church's response to HIV and AIDS in Africa, *renew* their resolve to own and scale-up Church responses and chart a *road-map* for a sustainable way forward.

Who Should Attend

Conference participants will be Christian HIV and AIDS workers from grassroots projects/programmes as well as strategic leaders and policy makers from churches and Christian networks and organisations working in the field of HIV and AIDS across Africa.

Participants should be committed to continue networking after the Conference, and to implementing outcomes strategically in order to bring about lasting change in the lives of those affected by HIV and AIDS.

The Cost

The conference will be held at Desalegn Hotel in Addis Ababa.

Registration Fee per Person

Ethiopian NGO/CBO or Church-based representation	\$50
Other African NGO/CBO or Church-based representation	\$100
International NGOs working in Africa or organisations based outside Africa	\$150

The Registration Fee is non-refundable.

Conference Fees per Person

This covers accommodation, food and the conference facilities from dinner on Wednesday 30th November to breakfast on Saturday 3rd December.

N.B. Rooms will be allocated strictly on a 'first come first serve' basis and will be guaranteed only to those who have paid in full prior to the conference.
